

How to Make a Victorian Paper Snowflake

- 1) Cut out the six-sided figure (hexagon).
- 2) Fold in half along a point-to-point axis so that the printed pattern is in the center of one of the halves. (See the dotted line.)
- 3) There are three equal-size edges on the half with the pattern. Fold the edge to the right of the pattern so that it meets the center edge in the portion with the pattern. Be sure you fold so you do not cover the pattern.
- 4) Repeat with the edge to the left of the pattern. Fold it under so its edge meets the center edge where the pattern is located. Again be sure not to cover the pattern.
- 5) Cut out the pattern by cutting away the portion in the center of the triangle.
- 6) Unfold to reveal your snowflake.
